



Expectations of a Cohort Director

WEEKLY

- The 1st two years the Cohort Director will work through all content with their cohort.

MONTHLY

- 2.5 hour cohort gathering.
- Cohort gatherings consist of (catching up, processing ChristianUniversity.org course content, further explanation of topics being covered, preparation / information for the next cohort gathering.
- Coaching calls/face 2 face meetings with leaders. One coaching session per month.
- Grading assignments

ANNUALLY

- Retreat in January
- Assessment of LEAD applications with other regional leaders
- 2 regional leadership summits per year.

ESTIMATED TIME REQUIRED

- A Cohort Director will put in the following amount of hours per month during their first 2 years and no less that 10 hours per month thereafter.
 - Cohort Gathering - 3 hours
 - Coaching Meetings - 4 hours
 - Grading - 3 hours
 - Learning and reviewing course content (first two years) - 10 hours
 - Learning and reviewing course content (Year 3 +) - 2 hours

PATHWAY TO BECOMING A COHORT DIRECTOR

APPLY

- Complete the Cohort Director Application Form and submit for review.

ACCEPT

- Pending the result of your application, you will be notified concerning your acceptance as a Cohort Leader.

ATTEND

- Attend at least one current LEAD Cohort Meeting.

TRAIN

- Attend Cohort Director Training (March or September)
- You will be assigned to train with an experienced Cohort Director for 4 months.

SUMMIT

- Attend 2 Cohort Director Summits per year in June and December for encouragement, evaluation and collaboration.
